Provided further that the appropriations for contingencies can only be expended upon appeal of two-thirds vote of Council for items of expense constituting a legal obligation against the village, and for purposes other than the other specific appropriations herein made.

Section 8. This ordinance shall take effect at the earliest period allowed by law.
