

IN THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF NEW CONCORD, OHIO

ORDINANCE No. 2019 – 9

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE FISCAL OFFICER TO DIRECT A PORTION OF THE WATER BILLING REVENUE TO THE WATER IMPROVEMENT FUND PER THE WATER SYSTEM ASSET MANAGEMENT PROGRAM AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Village of New Concord completed and is implementing an EPA mandated Water System Asset Management Program; and

WHEREAS, a necessary component of the program is funding for debt payments, future maintenance and capital improvements for the water system; and

WHEREAS, Ordinance 2019-2 provides for a necessary phased water rate increase in order to properly fund the Water Improvement Fund for said debt payments, maintenance and capital improvements; and

WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of public health, safety and welfare to immediately approve Ordinance 2019-8 to authorize the Fiscal Officer to direct necessary water billing revenue to the Water Improvement Fund.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDANED, by the Council of the Village of New Concord, Muskingum County, Ohio, as follows:

Section 1. The Fiscal Officer is authorized to direct water billing revenue, per the Asset Management Pro Forma, to the Water Improvement Fund.

Section 2. That for the reasons stated in the preamble, which is hereby made a part of hereof, the Ordinance is declared to be an emergency measure and shall take effect and be in force at the earliest period allowed by law.


