**ORDINANCE NO. D-1-19-1**

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND ORDINANCES D-1-03-2, D-2-97-1, D-1-98-1, D-5-93-1, D-3-91-1 AND D-2-91-2 ESTABLISHING CHARGES FOR WATER TAPS TO THE VILLAGE WATER SYSTEM, FINAL READING.

WHEREAS, the Council of the Village of New Concord must establish charges for water taps into the Village water system in order to operate the water system; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary that water tap fees be updated periodically; and

WHEREAS, it is in the interest of the health, safety and welfare of the Village that this Ordinance take effect upon passage.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it hereby ordained by the Council of the Village of New Concord as follows effective January 15, 2019:

The fee for lineal feet of excavation between the location of the water main and the curb boxes shall be:

\$20.00 - per lineal foot of street, alley, sidewalk, curb or other improved ground

\$10.00 - per lineal foot of unimproved ground

Excavation through rock, under utilities or more than four feet deep shall be considered extra ordinary. There shall be an extra charge for extraordinary installation requirements. Said charge shall be established by the Village Administrator.

Section 1. Tapping Charges. The following charges shall be made for connection to the Village water supply system both inside and outside the Village limits. All charges include materials and labor costs for a typical connection of each size. An appropriate excavation fee shall be added to each connection charge.

¾ inch                      \$1,700 - which includes the cost of all necessary materials and labor.

1 inch                      \$2,200 - which includes the cost of all necessary materials and labor.

2 inch                      \$6,600 - which includes the cost of all necessary materials and labor.

4 inch                      \$7,500 - which includes the cost of all necessary materials and labor.

6 inch                      \$9,300 – which includes the cost of all necessary materials and labor.

Water taps may be installed by outside contractors in new subdivisions or developments, providing that the design and installation is inspected and approved by the Village Administrator. In such cases, the tapping fee shall be reduced by an amount determined by the Village Administrator.

The Village shall be responsible for providing owner access to the water system at the curb stop near owner's property line after all fees are paid. The Village shall be responsible for materials required for


maintenance, repair and replacement of the water line from the tap on the main or feeder line to the curb stop. The owner shall be responsible for maintenance, repair and replacement of the water line from the curb stop to the property serviced with water.

Section 2. Charges for water connections outside Village limits shall no longer be 200% of the cost of connections inside the Village limits. All connections to the water system outside of Village limits shall now be the same fee as connections inside of Village limits. Fees for taps outside the corporation limits, listed in previous ordinances D-2-97-1, D-1-98-1, D-5-93-1, D-3-91-1 and D-2-91-2, shall be amended to reflect fees set forth in this ordinance upon passage by Village Council and approval of the Mayor.

Section 3. That the rates and charges set forth herein shall be in full force on the effective date listed above.

Section 4. For reasons stated in the preamble hereto, which is made a part hereof, this ordinance is hereby declared to be in full force after its passage and approval by the Mayor.
