

IN THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF NEW CONCORD, OHIO

ORDINANCE NO. D-1-98-2

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING D-3-91-1 AND ESTABLISHING REGULATIONS TO PERMIT SANITARY SEWER USE AND TAPS OUTSIDE THE VILLAGE LIMITS.

WHEREAS, Ordinance No. D-3-91-1 prohibits new sewer taps outside the Village limits;  
and

WHEREAS, in order to provide needed revenue for the sewer fund, it is necessary to permit outside taps in order to add customers under specific circumstances; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary to amend previous ordinances to permit said taps.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it ordained by the Village of New Concord that Ordinance No. D-3-91-1 shall be amended to include the following:

Section 1. Sewer taps outside the village limits may be approved by the Village Administrator when:


A. The tap is for a bonafide public sewer district, i.e. Muskingum or Guernsey County Sewer Districts and said district has entered into an interagency agreement with the Village.

B. The tap is for single residence or building, the owner and successive owners of which shall be responsible for maintaining the sewer line to the village corporate limits and the village owned sewer main. No other buildings or property shall be connected to said tap or line at any time. Each building shall be required to have a separate line and tap.

Section 2. All sewer taps shall be approved and inspected by the proper village official and all connecting lines shall be inspected and approved by the village and/or county plumbing inspector.


Section 3. Fees for outside taps to village owned sewers shall be two (2) times the established fee for in town taps.
