

IN THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF NEW CONCORD, OHIO

**ORDINANCE NO. E-2-97-1**

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND ORDINANCE NO. E-12-96-1 TO PROVIDE FOR A LUMP-SUM BONUS AND TO WAIVE THE RESIDENCY REQUIREMENT OF THE VILLAGE ADMINISTRATOR AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

**WHEREAS**, Ordinance No. E-12-96-1 established salaries and wages for 1997, including John W. Huey, Village Administrator, and;

**WHEREAS**, Mr. Huey has been evaluated upon the anniversary date of hire as set forth in Village policy, and;

**WHEREAS**, John W. Huey has performed his duties in an exemplary manner, showing initiative and service over and above that required by his job description, and;

**WHEREAS**, the Council of the Village of New Concord desires to recognize the Village Administrator for his efforts in obtaining development and grants for the Village, and;

**WHEREAS**, such compensation shall be a lump-sum of \$2,500 payable at once, and;

**WHEREAS**, Mr. Huey presently resides within thirty (30) miles of the Village of New Concord and Council has determined his outside residency has in no way been detrimental to the performance of his duties, and;

**WHEREAS**, Council desires to permit John W. Huey to live outside the Village and waive the residency requirement as permitted by the Ohio Revised Code, and;

**WHEREAS**, the immediate adoption of this ordinance is necessary for the preservation of the public health, safety and general welfare in that it is necessary to provide for the continuation of efficient operations of the Village of New concord, for the preservation of public peace, health and safety in the Village.

**NOW, THEREFORE**, be it ordained by the Council of the Village of New Concord, State of Ohio:

Section 1. That a lump sum bonus of \$2,500 be paid to John W. Huey.


Section 2. That the residency requirement for the Village Administrator set forth in the Ohio Revised Code shall be waived for John W. Huey as permitted by the Ohio Revised Code.


