RESOLUTION NO. 2019-1

A RESOLUTION TO AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH MUSKINGUM COUNTY FOR THE SALE OF **EMERGENCY** WATER SERVICES AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Village has identified the need for an emergency water connection with another water provider in the event of an unforeseen water shortage in the Village Water System. and:

WHEREAS, Muskingum County will be constructing a water line to serve county residents along the Village's western boundary, and;

WHEREAS, the County has agreed to provide the Village with emergency water in the amount of 270,000 gallons per day if necessary and the Village agrees to pay the annual debt payment to the County for construction of the waterline connection and any applicable water usage bills for water used, and;

WHEREAS, the immediate purchase of contractual services for the project is necessary for the health, safety and welfare of the Village.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved by the Council of the Village of New Concord, State of Ohio, that:

Section 1. It is hereby determined that the Mayor will enter into an agreement with Muskingum County for emergency water services.

Section 2. For the reasons stated in the preamble, this resolution shall take effect and be in full force at the earliest period allowed by law.
