A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE VILLAGE ADMINISTRATOR TO CONTRACT WITH CT CONSULTANTS FOR THE PURPOSE OF DEVELOPING A CYANOTOXIN GENERAL PLAN AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of the Village of New Concord, Ohio that:

<u>Section 1</u>. It is hereby determined that the Village Administrator shall contract with CT Consultants for the development of a Cyanotoxin General Plan at a cost not to exceed \$14,840.00.

<u>Section 3.</u> For the reasons stated in the preamble, this resolution shall take effect and be in full force at the earliest period allowed by law.
