RESOLUTION NO. 4-19-2

A RESOLUTION FOR THE VILLAGE ADMINISTRATOR TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH CT CONSULTANTS FOR THE LIBERTY ROAD REALIGNMENT FEASIBILITY STUDY AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Village has determined it necessary to identify an alternative access route between the northern and southern portions of the community for safety and ease of travel, and;

WHEREAS, it is necessary to perform an initial feasibility study on the proposed connection point to ensure viability, and;

WHEREAS, the immediate purchase of contractual services for the project is necessary for the health, safety and welfare of the Village.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved by the Council of the Village of New Concord, State of Ohio, that;

Section 1. It is hereby determined that the Village Administrator is authorized to enter into a contract with CT Consultants in an amount not to exceed \$7,500 for the Liberty Road Realignment Feasibility Study.

Section 2. For the reasons stated in the preamble, this resolution shall take effect and be in full force at the earliest period allowed by law.


