

IN THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF NEW CONCORD, OHIO

ORDINANCE NO. 2021 – 40

AN ORDINANCE TO AUTHORIZE THE MAYOR TO HIRE A FULL-TIME VILLAGE ADMINISTRATOR AND TO DECLARE AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, it is necessary for the immediate preservation of the safety and welfare of the Village of New Concord that the vacant position of Village Administrator be filled with a qualified candidate; and

WHEREAS, candidates have been considered and interviewed and Richard Giroux was selected as the best candidate for the job; and

WHEREAS, Section 735.271 of the Ohio Revised Code authorizes the mayor to appoint a Village Administrator with the consent and approval of Village Council; and

WHEREAS, Section 735.271 of the Ohio Revised Code requires approval for the Village Administrator to reside outside of the Village.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it ordained by the Council of the Village of New Concord, Ohio that:

Section 1. The mayor is hereby authorized to appoint Richard Giroux as Village Administrator of the Village of New Concord at an annual salary of \$74,000 effective August 10, 2021 which, according to the employment agreement, shall increase to \$75,000 after successful completion of a six-month probationary period.

Section 2. That Richard Giroux is hereby authorized to continue to reside in Cambridge, Ohio.

Section 2. That for the reasons stated in the preamble thereto, which is hereby made a part hereof, this Ordinance is declared to be an emergency measure and shall take effect and be in force at the earliest point allowed by law.
