RESOLUTION 2021 – 8 – 57

A RESOLUTION TO AUTHORIZE THE MAYOR TO ENTER INTO AN EMERGENCY VEHICLE PURCHASE AGREEMENT WITH PENN CARE, INC. AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Village must re-chassis the 2011 Braun Ford Ambulance (Medic 905) to continue to provide necessary services to residents, businesses and visitors in all served areas, and;

WHEREAS, Penn Care, Inc. is willing to sell the Village of New Concord a Braun Modular remount to a 2021/2022 Ford F-550 4x4 and necessary accessories, and;

WHEREAS, the immediate purchase of contractual services for the project is necessary for the health, safety and welfare of the Village.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved by the Council of the Village of New Concord, State of Ohio, that;


Section 1. It is hereby determined that the Mayor is authorized to enter into a purchase agreement with Penn Care, Inc. to purchase a 2021/2022 F-550 4x4 Remount Braun Chief XL and necessary accessories in an amount not to exceed \$158,000.

Section 2. For the reasons stated in the preamble hereto, which is made a part hereof, this resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure and shall take effect and be in force from the earliest period allowed by law
