**RESOLUTION NO. 2021 – 9 - 59**

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO PREPARE AND SUBMIT AN APPLICATION TO PARTICIPATE IN THE OHIO PUBLIC WORKS COMMISSION STATE CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM AND TO EXECUTE CONTRACTS AS REQUIRED AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the State Capital Improvement Program and the Local Transportation Improvement Program both provide financial assistance to political subdivisions for capital improvements to public infrastructure; and

WHEREAS, the Village of New Concord is planning to make capital improvements to the wastewater treatment plant tertiary filter; and

WHEREAS, the infrastructure improvement herein above described is considered to be a priority need for the community and is a qualified project under the OPWC programs; and

WHEREAS, it is immediately necessary for the health, safety and general welfare of the Village that this Resolution be considered and approved in order to comply with the requirements of the State Capital Improvement Program.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Village of New Concord, Ohio that:

Section 1: The Mayor is hereby authorized to apply to the OPWC for funds as described above.


Section 2: The Mayor or Village Administrator is authorized to enter into any agreements as may be necessary and appropriate for obtaining this financial assistance.
