**RESOLUTION NO. 2021 – 12 – 71**

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE FISCAL OFFICER TO ADVERTISE AND ACCEPT BIDS FOR 1991 SUTPHEN FIRE ENGINE AND TO PROCEED WITH SALE TO HIGHEST BIDDER AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, it has been determined that New Concord Fire Department Engine 902 (1991 Sutphen Fire Engine) has reached its end of service life and is now too expensive to operate; and

WHEREAS, due to several mechanical issues it is necessary to place the unit out of service for safety concerns; and

WHEREAS, it is periodically necessary to accept bids in order to sell unneeded Equipment and Apparatus; and


WHEREAS, the immediate sale of 1991 Sutphen Fire Engine, is necessary for the health, safety and welfare of the Village.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved by the Council of the Village of New Concord, Ohio:


Section 1. The Fiscal Officer is hereby authorized to advertise, accept bids, and sell to the highest bidder the 1991 Sutphen Fire Engine, owned by the Village.

Section 2. For the reasons stated in the preamble hereto, which is hereby made a part hereof, this resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure and shall take effect and be in force from the earliest period allowed by law.
