Resolution 2022-2-78

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE VILLAGE ADMINISTRATOR TO ENTER INTO A CONTRACT WITH CT ENGINEERING CONSULTANTS FOR PROFESSIONAL SERVICES RELATED TO IMPLEMENTATION OF THE NEW CONCORD WASTEWATER NPDES VIOLATION REMEDIATION PLAN AND COMPLIANCE SCHEDULE REQUIREMENTS AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Village of New Concord is required by the Ohio Environmental Protection Agency (OEPA) to comply with its Wastewater NPDES Permit OPB00028*HD.

WHEREAS, the Village of New Concord received a Notice of Violation in May 2019 regarding discharge of Total Suspended Solids (TSS), collection system inflow and infiltration (I/I) and Sanitary Sewer Overflows (SSO).

WHEREAS, the OEPA requires that the Village develop and implement a Wastewater NPDES Violation Remediation Plan and Compliance Schedule for compliance of its permit.

WHEREAS, the Village of New Concord requires the professional services of a qualified engineering firm to assist in the timely development of the NPDES Violation Remediation Plan and Compliance Schedule;


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of New Concord, Ohio:

Section 1. That the village administrator is hereby authorized to enter into contract for said professional services with CT Engineering Consultants of Columbus, Ohio for a sum of Thirty-Two Thousand Three Hundred Dollars (\$32,300.00) for development of said NPDES Violation Remediation Plan and Compliance Schedule.


Section 2. That the services to be provided by CT Engineering Consultants are tasks one through five as outlined and stipulated in the contract proposal, or Attachment A, to be completed and submitted to the OEPA no later than March 15, 2022.

Section 3. For the reasons stated in the preamble hereto, which is hereby made a part hereof, this resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure and shall take effect and be in force from the earliest period allowed by law for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, and safety of said Village of New Concord.
