RESOLUTION 2022 – 4 – 82

A RESOLUTION TO AUTHORIZE THE MAYOR TO ENTER INTO A PURCHASE AGREEMENT WITH PENN CARE INC. FOR AN AMBULANCE AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, it is necessary to replace the existing ambulance (“medic”) #902 which has outlived its useful life; and

WHEREAS, it is immediately necessary that the new medic be ordered to ensure delivery by 2024 according to the manufacturer’s production estimates; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary for the New Concord Fire Department to have three functional ambulances in order to provide services to residents, businesses and visitors in all served areas;

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved by the Council of the Village of New Concord, State of Ohio, that;

Section 1. The Mayor is authorized to enter into a purchase agreement with Penn Care, Inc. to purchase a 2023-2024 Ford F-550 Braun Liberty and necessary accessories in an amount not to exceed \$308,000.




