RESOLUTION 2022 - 3 - 80

A RESOLUTION TO SUBMIT LOCAL LIQUOR OPTION QUESTIONS TO THE NEW CONCORD ELECTORATE IN THE NOVEMBER 8, 2022 GENERAL ELECTION AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, according to the Ohio Department of Commerce, Division of Liquor Control, Village of New Concord is “dry” for D Class Permits for on premises liquor consumption; and,

WHEREAS, the Village of New Concord believes it is in the economic interest of the Village community to be “wet” for such permits; and,

WHEREAS, the question as to whether to be “wet” for such permits must be brought to the electors of the precinct of New Concord according to procedures specified within ORC Section 4301;

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Council of the Village of New Concord wish to ensure that the public is fully informed and therefore shall conduct a public information campaign that will include one or more public meetings solely on this ballot initiative;


NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved by the Council of the Village of New Concord, State of Ohio, that:
