Resolution 2022-5-86

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE VILLAGE ADMINISTRATOR TO ACCEPT AND ENTER INTO A GRANT AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE VILLAGE OF NEW CONCORD AND THE OHIO ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION AGENCY DIVISION OF DRINKING AND GROUNDWATERS TO RECEIVE UP TO FIFTY THOUSAND DOLLARS AWARD FROM THE LEAD SERVICE LINE MAPPING AND INVENTORY PROGRAM, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Village of New Concord received a Notice of Award on May 6, 2022 for fifty thousand dollars (\$50,000.00) in grant funding from the Ohio EPA Division of Drinking and Ground Waters Lead Service Line Mapping and Inventory Program, and


WHEREAS, the Village of New Concord has deemed developing and implementing a Lead Service Line Mapping and Inventory program is essential for the public health and welfare of its residents, and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the Village of New Concord, Ohio:

Section 1. That the village administrator is hereby authorized to enter into a grant agreement with the Ohio Environmental Protection Agency Division of Drinking and Ground Waters for the Village of New Concord to receive up to Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$50,000.00) from the Lead Service Line Mapping and Inventory Grant Program.

Section 2. For the reasons stated in the preamble hereto, which is hereby made a part hereof, this resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure and shall take effect and be in force from the earliest period allowed by law for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, and safety of said Village of New Concord.
