RESOLUTION 2022 – 7 – 91

**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE VILLAGE FISCAL OFFICER TO
ISSUE A THEN AND NOW CERTIFICATE FOR A PURCHASE AND
DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.**

WHEREAS, Ohio Revised Code Section 5705.41 (d) provides a process for a Village Council, as a political subdivision of the state, to authorize Then and Now Certificates to cover financial commitments made to vendors or other parties by the Village prior to a Fiscal Officer Certification, through formal purchase order or otherwise; and

WHEREAS, the Fiscal Officer is accordingly certifying that there were appropriations available and funds in the treasury or in the process of collection at the time the contract or order was made (then), and there are still sufficient appropriations and funds in the treasury or in the process of collection at the time the certificate is being issued (now); and


WHEREAS, Council now desires to authorize the drawing of a warrant in payment of the amounts due upon such contract or order.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved by the Council of the Village of New Concord, State of Ohio, that:

Section 1. That the drawing of warrants in payment to satisfy 5% Cost Match of Fire Department FEMA Grant Award EMW-2020-FG-14224 in the amount of \$8,811.80.


Section 2. That this measure constitutes an emergency measure for the immediate preservation of public peace, health and safety and shall take effect and be in force at the earliest period allowed by law.


