**RESOLUTION 2022-8-95**

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE VILLAGE ADMINISTRATOR TO PREPARE AND SUBMIT AN APPLICATION TO PARTICIPATE IN THE OHIO PUBLIC WORKS COMMISSION STATE CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM AND TO EXECUTE CONTRACTS AS REQUIRED AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

**WHEREAS**, the State Capital Improvement Program and the Local Transportation Improvement Program both provide financial assistance to political subdivisions for capital improvements to public infrastructure, and

**WHEREAS**, the Village of New Concord is planning to make capital improvements to the Wastewater Treatment Plant Clarifier #2 Replacement Project, and

**WHEREAS**, the infrastructure improvement herein above described is considered to be a priority need for the community and is a qualified project under the OPWC programs,

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Village of New Concord:

**Section 1:** The Village Administrator is hereby authorized to apply to the OPWC for funds as described above.

**Section 2:** The Village Administrator is authorized to enter into any agreements as may be necessary and appropriate for obtaining this financial assistance.

**Section 3:** For the reasons stated in the preamble hereto, which is hereby made a part hereof, this resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure and shall take effect and be in force from the earliest period allowed by law.


