RESOLUTION 2022 – 9 – 97

A RESOLUTION REPEALING RESOLUTION 2022-5-89 AND AUTHORIZE THE FISCAL OFFICER TO ENTER INTO A MUNICIPAL LEASE PURCHASE AGREEMENT FOR FINANCING FIRE AND POLICE MOTOROLA EQUIPMENT AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Village has identified major safety services communications equipment replacements that must be completed as soon as possible, and;

WHEREAS, Motorola Solutions, Inc. has provided a Tax-exempt Municipal Lease Purchase Agreement approach to assist the Village in accomplishing these necessary improvements, and;

WHEREAS, the immediate purchase of the required safety services communications equipment is necessary for the health, safety and welfare of the Village.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved by the Council of the Village of New Concord, State of Ohio, that;

Section 1. It is hereby determined that the Fiscal Officer is authorized to enter into a Municipal Lease Purchase Agreement with Motorola Solutions, Inc. for communications equipment for New Concord Fire Department in the amount of \$74,298.96 Said agreement is five-year term with an interest rate not to exceed 5.19%, effective 9/1/2022.

Section 2. It is hereby determined that the Fiscal Officer is authorized to enter into a Municipal Lease Purchase Agreement with Motorola Solutions, Inc. for communications equipment for New Concord Police Department in the amount of \$45,312.51. Said agreement is five-year term with an interest rate not to exceed 5.19%, effective 9/1/2022.


