**RESOLUTION 2022-10-101**

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE VILLAGE ADMINISTRATOR TO PREPARE AND SUBMIT AN APPLICATION TO PARTICIPATE IN THE APPALACHIAN REGIONAL COMMISSION AND/OR OHIO GOVERNOR'S OFFICE OF APPALACHIA PROGRAMS AND EXECUTE CONTRACTS AS REQUIRED AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

**WHEREAS**, the Appalachian Regional Commission (ARC) and Ohio Governor's Office of Appalachia (GOA) provide financial assistance for equipment and capital improvements, and

**WHEREAS**, the Village of New Concord is planning to make capital improvements to the Wastewater Treatment Plant Tertiary Treatment Filter Replacement Project, and

**WHEREAS**, the proposed infrastructure improvement herein above described is considered to be a priority need for the community and is a qualified project under the ARC and GOA programs, and

**WHEREAS**, the Village of New Concord is requesting a grant from the ARC and/or GOA programs in the amount of \$250,000 for said project, and

**WHEREAS**, the Village of New Concord has the matching funds in the amount of \$649,800 from other grants, loans and/or local funds for said project.

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Village of New Concord:

**Section 1:** The Village Administrator is hereby authorized to apply to the ARC and/or GOA programs for funds as described above.


**Section 2:** The Village Administrator is authorized to enter into any agreements as may be necessary and appropriate for obtaining this financial assistance.

**Section 3:** For the reasons stated in the preamble hereto, which is hereby made a part hereof, this resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure and shall take effect and be in force from the earliest period allowed by law.
