RESOLUTION NO. 2022 – 11 – 105

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CHIEF OF POLICE TO SELL THE POLICE DEPARTMENT'S BELGIAN MALINOIS K9 DOG TO POLICE OFFICER JEFF TRAUB IN LIEU OF DISBURSEMENT OF UNUSED COMPENSATION TIME AND VACATION PAY IN THE AMOUNT OF FOUR THOUSAND THREE HUNDRED SEVENTY DOLLARS AND EIGHTY-EIGHT CENTS (\$4,370.88) AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, it has been determined that police K9 dogs are specific to their police officer handler; and

WHEREAS, Police Officer Jeff Traub, K9 Handler, will leave Village employment on November 30, 2022, and

WHEREAS, it is at the request of Officer Traub to purchase the Belgian Malinois K9 dog Norco; and

WHEREAS, it is fiscally prudent to sell the Belgian Malinois K9 dog for the value of Officer Traub's unused vacation pay and compensation time for the sum of \$4,370.88.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved by the Council of the Village of New Concord, Ohio:


Section 1. The Chief of Police is hereby authorized to sell the New Concord Police Department's Belgian Malinois K9 dog to Police Officer Jeff Traub for the sum of \$4,370.88 being equal to Officer Traub's cash out value of his unused compensation time and vacation pay owed by the Village.

Section 2. For the reasons stated in the preamble hereto, which is hereby made a part hereof, this resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure and shall take effect and be in force from the earliest period allowed by law.


