RESOLUTION 2022-12-107

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE VILLAGE MAYOR TO PREPARE, SUBMIT AND ENTER INTO A JOINT APPLICATION TO THE APPALACHIAN COMMUNITY GRANT PROGRAM VIA THE OHIO DEPARTMENT OF DEVELOPMENT AND ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT(S) CONTINGENT UPON AWARD AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Appalachian Community Grant Program (“ACGP”), created by House Bill 377, provides support to political subdivisions, educational institutions, port authorities, community improvement corporations, and nonprofits within the 32-county Ohio Appalachian region to undertake projects related to Downtown Redevelopment/Infrastructure, Workforce, and Healthcare, and

WHEREAS, collaborative and regionally transformative projects are strongly encouraged by the ACGP sponsor, Ohio Department of Development, and

WHEREAS, the Village of New Concord, Muskingum University, The Wilds, Genesis Healthcare Systems and Connect Real Estate have agreed to apply jointly to the ACGP with Muskingum University as lead applicant, and

WHEREAS, this public-private partnership, if the application is successful, will bring regional enhancements to our communities through infrastructure, technology, education, tourism, outdoor amenities and healthcare.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Village of New Concord:

Section 1: The Village Mayor is hereby authorized to apply for an Appalachian Community Grant via the Ohio Department of Development in join application.


Section 2: The Village Mayor is authorized to enter into any agreements as may be necessary and appropriate contingent upon a grant award.

Section 3: For the reasons stated in the preamble hereto, which is hereby made a part hereof, this resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure and shall take effect and be in force from the earliest period allowed by law.


