RESOLUTION NO. 2022 – 12 – 111

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE FISCAL OFFICER TO ADVERTISE AND ACCEPT BIDS FOR NEW CONCORD POLICE DEPARTMENT 2016 FORD SEDAN INTERCEPTOR NUMBER ONE AND 2015 FORD EXPLORER INTERCEPTOR NUMBER FIVE (K9) AND TO PROCEED WITH SALE TO HIGHEST BIDDER AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, it has been determined that New Concord Police Department Ford Interceptors Number 1 (One) and Number 5 (Five) (K9) have reached the end of their service lives; and

WHEREAS, due to multiple mechanical issues it is necessary to place both units out of service for safety concerns; and

WHEREAS, there will not be a New Concord K9 Officer for at least twelve months due to training requirements; and

WHEREAS, it is periodically necessary to accept bids in order to sell unneeded Equipment and Apparatus; and

WHEREAS, the immediate sale of Police Department Ford Interceptors Number 1 and Number 5 (K9) is necessary for the safety and welfare of the Village.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved by the Council of the Village of New Concord, Ohio:


Section 1. The Fiscal Officer is hereby authorized to advertise, accept bids, and sell to the highest bidder the Police Department Ford Interceptors Number 1 and Number 5 (K9), owned by the Village.

Section 2. For the reasons stated in the preamble hereto, which is hereby made a part hereof, this resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure and shall take effect and be in force from the earliest period allowed by law.
