RESOLUTION 2023 – 3 – 113

A RESOLUTION TO AUTHORIZE THE MAYOR TO ENTER INTO A PURCHASE AGREEMENT WITH SUTPHEN CORPORATION FOR A NEW FIRE DEPARTMENT ENGINE AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the New Concord Fire Department must have reliable emergency equipment to provide necessary services to residents, businesses and visitors in all served areas, and;

WHEREAS, Engine 902 was built in 1992, is no longer serviceable and has been taken out of service, and;

WHEREAS, in order to provide coverage and necessary services the New Concord Fire Department must have two reliable engines, and;


WHEREAS, delivery of this engine from Sutphen Corporation is 37-43 months after ordering, so the immediate purchase of contractual services for this item is necessary for the health, safety and welfare of the Village.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved by the Council of the Village of New Concord, Ohio, that;


Section 1. The Mayor is authorized to enter into a purchase agreement with Sutphen Corporation to purchase a new engine for the New Concord Fire Department in an amount not to exceed \$958,399.

Section 2. For the reasons stated in the preamble hereto, which is made a part hereof, this resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure and shall take effect and be in force from the earliest period allowed by law.
