RESOLUTION NO. 2023-5-118

A RESOLUTION BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF NEW CONCORD, OHIO IN THE MATTER OF THE APPROVAL OF THE SOLID WASTE MANAGEMENT PLAN FOR THE SOUTHEASTERN OHIO JOINT SOLID WASTE MANAGEMENT DISTRICT, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Council of the Village of New Concord is situated within the geographic boundaries of the Southeastern Ohio Joint Solid Waste Management District (the District); and

WHEREAS, the Policy Committee for the District adopted a draft Solid Waste Management Plan on March 6, 2023, for the fifteen-year period beginning in 2023 and ending in 2037; and

WHEREAS, the draft Solid Waste Management Plan for the District was submitted to council for its review in accordance with the requirements of Chapters 343 and 3734 of the Ohio Revised Code:

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Village of New Concord, Muskingum County, Ohio, that:

Section 1. The draft Solid Waste Management Plan for the Southeastern Ohio Joint Solid Waste Management District is hereby ratified.

Section 2. A copy of this resolution will be mailed by the Clerk of Council to the District Coordinator at the District's office at 46049 Marietta Road, Suite 6, Caldwell, Ohio 43724.

Section 3. It is found and determined that all formal actions of the Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council and that all deliberations of Council of any of its committees that resulted in those formal actions were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with the law.

Section 4. For the reasons stated in the preamble hereto, this resolution shall be an emergency measure and shall take effect immediately.
