# October 10, 2023

Mayor Jennifer Lyle called the meeting to order on Tuesday, October 10, 2023 with all members present.

Moved by Wootton, seconded by Whitehair, that council dispense with the reading of the September 11, 2023 minutes and approve as distributed. Motion carried. Moved by Shegog, seconded by Taylor, that council dispense with the reading of the September 25, 2023 minutes and approve as distributed. Motion carried.

Colleen Heacock asked what was the aggregate increase in the tax levy, if there was any pause given the significant increase in the percent of income tax, and when was the last increase in the income tax? Marlatt responded that there will be a projected gain of \$340,000 in 2024, \$348,000 in 2025, \$356,700 in 2026, and \$365,000 in 2027. Lyle stated that council decided to ask for an increase to match what is needed to balance the budget in 2024. Lyle stated that the last increase was in 2014 and was specifically for safety services, with the fire department changing to part-time employees from an all volunteer fire department.

Mike Kruzan stated that he is in favor of these services, especially in light of the loss of businesses that are beginning to come back into the Village.

June Kruzan asked about the rates for electric and gas services. Erin Stevens explained that most municipalities have seen 41-45% savings, and that there is no termination fee. She explained that following a vote in favor of the aggregation on Election Day, there will be a public hearing. She stated that residents are able to opt out at any time.

Dave Adams explained that East Muskingum School District is asking for a renewal levy and an additional levy.
