

IN THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF NEW CONCORD, OHIO

ORDINANCE NO. 2024 – 2--1

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO HIRE A FULL-TIME INTERIM VILLAGE ADMINISTRATOR AND FULL-TIME INTERIM FISCAL OFFICER AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, it is necessary that the vacant positions of Village Administrator and Village Fiscal Officer be filled with qualified candidates; and

WHEREAS, candidates have been considered and interviewed and Christopher Huebner and Debra Whitehair were selected as the best candidates for the job; and

WHEREAS, Section 735.271 of the Ohio Revised Code authorizes the Mayor to appoint a Village Administrator with the approval of Village Council; and requires approval for the Village Administrator to reside outside of the Village; and

WHEREAS, Section 733.262 of the Ohio Revised Code, authorizes the Mayor to appoint a Village Fiscal Officer with the approval of Village Council; and requires approval for the Village Fiscal Officer to reside outside of the Village; and

WHEREAS, it is in the interest of the public peace, health, safety, general welfare and fiscal integrity of the Village that this ordinance take effect immediately.

NOW THEREFORE, be it ordained by the Council of the Village of New Concord, Ohio that:

SECTION 1. Village Council hereby waives the residency requirement and approves the appointment of Chris Huebner as Interim Village Administrator of the Village of New Concord effective January 8, 2024 for ninety (90) days or less and of Debra Whitehair as Interim Fiscal Officer effective January 12, 2024 for ninety (90) days or less.




