

IN THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF NEW CONCORD, OHIO

RESOLUTION 2024 – 4 - 4

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO ACCEPT A FUNDING AWARD FOR A MUNICIPAL FACILITIES PLANNING AND DESIGN PROGRAM FROM THE MAYORS' PARTNERSHIP FOR PROGRESS VIA ITS FISCAL AGENT OHIO UNIVERSITY VOINOVICH SCHOOL OF LEADERSHIP AND PUBLIC SERVICE AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, New Concord Village Hall has received no significant upgrades since its 1960s era construction and is difficult to secure for staff safety and the safety of the public; and

WHEREAS, it is of the utmost importance to provide adequate, safe and compliant facilities for police, fire and administrative personnel; and

WHEREAS, funding for professional expertise and resources is required in order to make the best possible decisions for this essential infrastructure; and

WHEREAS, the Mayors' Partnership for Progress (MPP) was allocated funds by the Voinovich School of Leadership and Public Service under an agreement with the State of Ohio, Department of Development, with said funds to assist in the MPP mission; and

WHEREAS, these funds were used in part to establish a funding program to support payment of subject matter experts to assist MPP and its members in undertaking various public functions; and

WHEREAS, the Village of New Concord, as a member in good standing of the MPP, made a request to its funding program for planning and design services for security and essential infrastructure needs; and

WHEREAS, the aforementioned request from the Village of New Concord was approved for participation in the MPP funding program, which will directly pay all costs and fees described in the proposed Scope of Work (Exhibit A); and

WHEREAS, it is necessary for the health, safety and welfare of the Village to proceed immediately with the program to comply with timing requirements of the available funding.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it hereby resolved by the Council of the Village of New Concord, Ohio that:

Section 1. The mayor is authorized on behalf of the Village of New Concord to enter into the Participation and Services Agreement (Exhibit B) between Ohio University's School of Leadership and Public Service and APG Architects.


