

IN THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF NEW CONCORD, OHIO

ORDINANCE NO. 2024 – 9 – 1

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE A CONTRACT WITH A REGIONAL COUNCIL OF GOVERNMENTS FOR THE PURPOSE OF ADMINISTRATION AND COLLECTION OF MUNICIPAL INCOME TAX IN THE VILLAGE OF NEW CONCORD, OHIO

WHEREAS, a Regional Council of Governments was created pursuant to Chapter 167 of the Ohio Revised Code to foster cooperation between municipalities, and

WHEREAS, the creation of the Regional Council of Governments was primarily to establish a central collection facility (Regional Income Tax Agency) for the purpose of administering the Income Tax Laws of the various participating members communities.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF NEW CONCORD, COUNTY OF MUSKINGUM, AND STATE OF OHIO:

- Section 1. That the Mayor be and is hereby authorized and directed to execute, on behalf of the Village of New Concord, a contract with a Regional Council of Governments for the administration and collection of the Village of New Concord's Income Tax effective January 1, 2024.
- Section 2. Pursuant to Section 3 of the Agreement, the Village of New Concord Fiscal Officer is hereby approved as representative to the Council of Governments and the Mayor of the Village of New Concord be and hereby is designated as alternate to the Council of Governments.
- Section 3. It is found and determined that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Ordinance were taken in an open meeting or meetings of this Council and any of its committees that resulted in such formal action, were in full compliance with all legal requirements, including, without limitation, those set forth in section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
