**RESOLUTION 2025 – 7 – 1**

A RESOLUTION CREATING THE FEE STRUCTURE AS ESTABLISHED BY HOUSE BILL 315, PASSED JANUARY 2, 2025 BY GOVERNOR DEWINE FOR THE CHARGING OF FEES IN PUBLIC RECORDS REQUESTS THAT INCLUDE VIDEOS OF POLICE DEPARTMENT INCIDENTS AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

**WHEREAS**, the Police Department of the Village of New Concord uses body-worn cameras; and

**WHEREAS**, copies of the videos from said cameras are often requested by various entities as a public records request; and

**WHEREAS**, House Bill 315, signed by Governor DeWine on January 2, 2025 allows for the charging of fees related to the inspection, redaction and editing of video from Law Enforcement Agencies.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF NEW CONCORD, OHIO THAT:**

**Section 1.** That Council hereby approves of fees to be charged at a rate of \$50.00 per hour, which is below the maximum amount allowed of \$75.00 per hour, up to a total of \$750.00 per request.

**Section 2.** That Council finds and determines that all formal actions relative to the passage of this ordinance were taken in an open meeting and that all deliberations of Council which resulted in the passage of this resolution, were taken in meetings open to the public, in full compliance with all legal requirements including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.

**Section 3.** That this measure constitutes an emergency measure for the immediate preservation of public peace, health and safety and shall take effect and be in force at the earliest period allowed by law.
